

### **GRAD POLICY**

   hours component AND <u>90 credits</u>
   by the end of Quarter 3
- OR, Have a specialized program as part of an ISP.

### CCHS GRADUATION: OUR GIFT TO OUR STUDENTS






In working with the Enmax, we have determined that a stage will be set up facing north (concert/ half-ice set up).

All graduates and staff will use the "Player's Entrance" for all events at the Enmax.

All guests (family and invited friends) will use the Enmax "public" north-facing doors (that would typically be used for hockey games or concerts). No guests will be allowed access to the floor as this would be reserved for graduates and staff.

The only time that we will invite families and invited friends to the floor would be AFTER the Grand March. The announcer will do so <u>after</u> the Graduating Class of 2024 is introduced. An invitation for guests to come to the floor for a dance (grad-parent and grad-family/friend) and pictures will be announced.

### **GRADUATION MASS**



Friday, May 10, 7:00 PM at Enmax

Grads arrive at 6:15 p.m. through the "Player's Entrance" at Enmax. Grads will be lined up alphabetically.

Only grads and CCH Staff will be allowed in the lower concourse and floor.

Grads wear their gowns, but no caps. Appropriate attire underneath.

Cell phones should be left with a parent.

No gum.

Mass includes the grad candle lighting ceremony.

### **GRADUATION CEREMONIES**



Saturday, May 11, 9:00 AM at Enmax

Grads arrive through "Player's Entrance" at Enmax at 8:15 AM and line up alphabetically in the lower concourse.

Only grads will be allowed on the floor and in the lower concourse. Parents, guardians, and guests are welcome to take a seat in the lower and upper bowls.

Grads will need their gowns and caps.

Suggestions: Boys – white shirt and tie; girls – v-neck t-shirt.

Grads should write their names in their caps – they keep these.

Again, no cell phones or chewing gum.
