The Real Story

How we envisioned it...

- Meet with a teacher in a small group or on a 1:1 basis for additional help.
- Meet with a teacher in a small group for enrichment or enhancement activities.
- Pursue personal fitness goals in the Fitness Centre
- Take part in supervised athletic activities in the gym
- Attend a scheduled meeting with a teacher to complete missed work, take tests or receive additional help.
- Work on assigned projects with other students.
- Attend club meetings and activities

What actually happened (good)

- "Students and teachers were able to move between campuses.
- "Some clubs met.
- Some students worked out more.
- "Some students got extra help.

More good things

- "Some teachers/committees met.
- "Teachers had time to refocus, get caught up, etc.
- Religious celebrations could happen.

What actually happened(less good)

- Kids thought flex time was an automatic dismissal.
- "Teachers weren't all that clear on how to designate flex time.
- "Lunch got longer.
- "Fridays were REALLY long.

What It SHOULD be.

- Teacher determined and teacher led
- "Available to students who CHOOSE it.
- "Required for students who NEED it.

How can we make this happen?

- "Teachers should determine which of their students NEED flex time to complete missed work, write tests.
- These students should be designated by the teacher to STAY during flex time.

And even more...

- "Teachers need to be available at flex time.
- We will not ring a bell for the start of flex time to alleviate the "bell dismisses me" concept.

IT'S NOT A STUDENT CHOICE

Common Language

- "Flex time is flexible LEARNING time.
- "Flex time is designated by the TEACHER.
- "Student choice on how to use flex time ENDS when the student makes poor choices.



Problems:

- "A student in a PM class could benefit from flex time.
- "Students can't stay because they need to catch the shuttle.
- "Friday flex is really long.
- Kids see it as longer lunch

- Designate that student to come during AM flex time; if the student chooses not to come, it becomes a defiance issue.
- If this becomes an ongoing problem with a particular students, we can arrange alternate transportation.
- We have reduced that time and added it to classroom time.
- Ask the cafeteria NOT to open until 11:00 a.m.

"Mon-Thurs: leaves CW at 11:15 and CE

at 11:00

"Fridays: Leaves both

sites at 10:00

- We all have the same understanding.
