

## Grade 12 Checklist

- ✓ Check out how many credits you have as of September 2017; how many credits you will have as of June 2018.
- ✓ Make sure that you have **Alberta High School Diploma** requirements.
- ✓ Decide on the post-secondary program that you would like to take after Grade 12 graduation.
- ✓ Check on the high school **prerequisites** for the particular program.
- ✓ Choose two institutions that offer the same program on <http://www.myblueprint.ca/> that you would like to attend.
- ✓ What are the tuition fees at these institutions?
- ✓ Find out when you can apply for admission to the college or university.
- ✓ If you would like to do apprenticeship, find an employer who would hire you as part of RAP-See Mrs. Gurr in Room 154 CCH East.
- ✓ **Apply** to the college or university at <https://www.applyalberta.ca/pub/> Make sure you have a credit card. There is an application fee.
- ✓ Order a copy of your official high school transcript to be sent directly from Alberta Learning to the institutions you have applied to. The transcript can be ordered now; it will arrive at the institution after you have completed Quarter four. <http://www.education.alberta.ca/students/transcripts.aspx>
- ✓ Check on **housing**. In some cases applications to universities and college residences have to be sent in early.
- ✓ Check on **financing**- loans, scholarships or bursaries. Be sure to fill out a blanket application for any entrance scholarship at the institution you will be attending. Deadlines vary.

- ✓ Keep your school marks as high as you are able. Some educational institutions grant Early Admission on marks from Quarter one and two. Some programs at both colleges and university are very competitive academically.
